



Postdoctoral Fellowships for Female Researchers (all disciplines) at the University of Vienna

The overall goal of the **RE**inforcing **W**omen In **RE**search (REWIRE) Programme is to **support the careers of excellent postdoctoral female researchers** at the University of Vienna.

What we offer:

- A 36-month fellowship in any discipline offered at the University of Vienna
- A highly competitive programme supporting you in your academic career progression and becoming a mentor for future female researchers
- Working at the largest research and education institution in Austria
- The chance to live in Vienna the city with the highest quality of life in the world for 10 years in a row!

In addition to your individual research project and customised career development plan, you will be encouraged to:

- Be part of and build upon an enhanced research network
- Participate in non-research oriented training programmes
- Develop transferable skills
- Gain international exposure through publications in high-profile journals
- Participate in international conferences

Applicants must:

- Be female
- Have been awarded their PhD or will have successfully defended their PhD before the start of the fellowship
- Comply with the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Mobility Rule (applicants must not have resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in Austria for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately before the relevant call deadline)
- Submit a complete application (in English) before the specific call deadline

Applicants will need to submit a support letter from a hosting mentor as part of their application. A list of participating departments is available on our website. Applicants may also reach out to other potential mentors who fit their research profiles and are employed at the University of Vienna.

Fellows will be employed at the University of Vienna for the duration of the fellowship and be paid a postdoctoral researcher salary in line with <u>Austria's Collective Bargaining Agreement for University</u> <u>Staff</u> (salary group B1(b), the current 2018 salary is 3,803.90 EUR (gross), payable 14 times a year).

The first call for applications opens 1st July 2019. Application form and Guide for Applicants will be published on our website. Deadline for applications: 30th September 2019.

The second call for applications is expected to open on 15th February 2020 and close on 15th April 2020.
